**RE: Petition of Essex A North Lot Solar, LLC for a certificate of public good in pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248 for a 3.5 MW ground-mounted solar array off Robinson Parkway in Essex Junction, Vermont.**

Dear Director Poor:

Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 202(f), Essex A North Lot Solar, LLC requests a determination by the Department of Public Service that the proposal to construct a 3.5 MW ground-mounted solar array off Robinson Parkway in Essex Junction, Vermont (referred to as the “Project”) is consistent with the Vermont Twenty-Year Electric Plan.

The Project is described in greater detail in a Petition and Prefiled Testimony of Jake Clark, Adam Crary, Stephanie Wyman, and Jeremy Owens, which I am submitting to the Public Utility Commission today for approval under 30 V.S.A § 248. The Department will have access to the file via ePUC.
