SCHEDULING CONFERENCE ORDER

This case involves an investigation of the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) concerning the Energy Savings Account (“ESA”) program and the Customer Credit Program (“CCP”) to implement changes to 30 V.S.A. 209(d)(3)(C) pursuant to Public Act 142 of the 2024 Vermont legislative session.

On July 26, 2024, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a proposed schedule for this proceeding.

On July 30, 2024, I held a scheduling conference in this matter. The scheduling conference was attended by representatives of the Department; the Vermont Agency of Commerce and Community Development; Associated Industries of Vermont; Efficiency Vermont; WestRock; Collins Aerospace; Champlain Water District; Killington Ski Resort; and Mack Molding Company.

At the scheduling conference, the participants discussed the schedule proposed by the Department. Based on the discussion, I adopt the following proposed schedule.

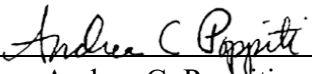
Date	Event
August 22, 2024	Department files proposal for program design changes to the ESA and CCP
September 12, 2024	Parties file comments on the Department’s proposal
September 19, 2024	Commission issues information requests to parties
October 17, 2024	Department files reply comments; Responses to information request due
30 days after Commission order	Department makes compliance filing consisting of final program-design descriptions for the ESA and CCP based on the Commission’s order

30 days after compliance filing	Request for Proposals issued for the ESA and CCP programs
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Any person or entity wishing to participate in this case should email or contact the Clerk of the Commission. Importantly, the participant will be able to file documents directly into the case in ePUC. The participant will also receive email notifications via ePUC when documents are filed or issued.
