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NOTICE OF INTERVENTION


Pursuant to Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “PUC”) Rules 2.209(A) and 5.409, the Town of Lyndon Electric Department (“LED”), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby files its notice of intervention in the above-caption matter. In support of this motion, LED states as follows:

1. LED provides service in the Town of Lyndon where the proposed electrical generation facility (the “Facility”) that is the subject of this docket will be located.
2. LED will be the interconnecting utility for the Facility.
3. Pursuant to PUC Rule 5.409, it may obtain intervenor status by filing a notice of intervention.
4. LED is seeking to participate on the following issues: 30 V.S.A. § 248(b)(3) (system stability and reliability) and 30 V.S.A. § 248(b)(10) (transmission facilities).
5. LED requests intervention as a right in this docket under Rule 2.209(A). LED has an interest in this docket in that the proposed generation facility will be located within LED’s service territory and interconnected with LED’s distribution system. It therefore has an interest that must be resolved in this proceeding and is so situated that the disposition of the proceeding will, as a practical matter, impair or impede LED’s ability to protect that interest.

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, LED asks the Commission to grant its
intervene.
