EFFICIENCY VERMONT PROPOSED SCHEDULE

On September 13, 2024, Efficiency Vermont filed its *Motion To Amend its Approved 2024-2026 Demand Resources Plan* (the “DRP Amendment”) with the Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) in the above-referenced matter. To develop the proposed DRP Amendment, Efficiency Vermont consulted with representatives of the Department of Public Service (the “Department”) in an effort to formulate a proposal that would be acceptable to the Department.

Pursuant to the Commission’s *Order Establishing Schedule and Expanding Scope of Proceeding* dated July 24, 2024, Efficiency Vermont is required to file a proposed schedule for review of non-consensus DRP Amendment elements at this time. As of this writing, Efficiency Vermont is not aware of any non-consensus DRP Amendment elements and is awaiting feedback from the Department. As a result, Efficiency Vermont proposes that the Commission amend its July 24th Scheduling Order to give Efficiency Vermont and the Department additional time to determine if there are any non-consensus elements. Specifically Efficiency Vermont proposes the following:

September 20, 2024 to September 27, 2024	Informal Discovery on Efficiency Vermont re proposed DRP Amendment

October 18, 2024	Deadline for Non-Petitioning Parties to file notice of consensus DRP Amendment elements, comments and/or supporting testimony and exhibits regarding consensus DRP Amendment elements
October 25, 2024	Based on consultation with the Department, Efficiency Vermont files a schedule for the remainder of the review of the proposed DRP Amendment

While this change to the Commission’s Scheduling Order will engender a slight delay in the resolution of the outstanding matters in this investigation, Efficiency Vermont believes it represents a direct path that will move the matter forward.

An advance copy of this submission was shared with the DPS. I am authorized to represent that the Department concurs with the proposed schedule.
