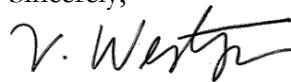
The purpose of this letter is to provide you notice that Reservoir Road Solar, LLC has submitted a petition to the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or “Commission”) for approval of a 2.375 MW solar electric generation facility to be located in Berkshire, Vermont (the “Project”). The Project will occupy approximately 10.5 acres on portions of two adjoining parcels off of Reservoir Road and will be accessed using an existing drive off Reservoir Road. The Commission deemed the petition administratively complete on December __, 2024 and has opened a new case to review the Project, which has been assigned Case No. 24-____-PET.
