Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) intends to follow this investigation directly, as it presents the first proposed use of a new electricity generation technology in Vermont and seeks to contract the output of the facility through the Standard Offer program at a price that creates substantial cost for GMP customers. GMP and its customers therefore have a direct interest in whether the facility properly may participate in the Standard Offer program under the category it seeks.

While GMP does not possess technical expertise in the new technology proposed and does not expect to provide testimony or other evidence on those specific topics, it would like to preserve the right to file comments and briefing to protect the interests of GMP and its customers in the proper application of the Standard Offer program to this new proposed technology. While the schedule in this matter does not contemplate interventions, GMP is pleased to file a formal motion to intervene if necessary to participate as contemplated above.
