**WOODSTOCK AQUEDUCT COMPANY’S UPDATE
ON THE SALE OF THE COMPANY, MOTION TO CONTINUE STAY,
AND FURTHER WAIVER OF STATUTORY PERIOD**

Woodstock Aqueduct Company (“WAC”) submits the following update on the sale of the company, moves the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to continue the stay in the above-captioned proceeding until May 15, 2025, and waives the statutory period for a decision to issue in this matter until then as well. In support of this request, WAC provides the following:

On March 18, 2025, WAC filed a petition with the Commission seeking approval of the sale of all of WAC’s utility assets to the Town of Woodstock. The proceeding has been assigned the Case Number 25-0514-PET. Parties have requested and are hoping for approval by April 30, 2025. Accordingly, WAC moves to stay the above-captioned proceeding until May 15, 2025 to give the Commission time to issue a decision on the petition in Case No. 25-0514-PET. WAC also hereby waives the statutory period for a decision to issue in this matter until May 15, 2025 as well.

Undersigned counsel is authorized to represent that the Department of Public Service and the Town and Village of Woodstock have no objection to this request.
