ORDER EXTENDING STAY

This case concerns a tariff filing made by Woodstock Aqueduct Company (“Woodstock Aqueduct”) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) requesting a 109.82% increase in Woodstock Aqueduct’s overall revenue.

On January 3, 2025, I issued an order granting Woodstock Aqueduct’s motion to stay this proceeding until March 31, 2025. Woodstock Aqueduct requested the stay to enable it to focus on finalizing transactional documents necessary to move forward with the sale of the utility to the Town of Woodstock. I also set a deadline of March 31, 2025, for the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) and Woodstock Aqueduct to submit responses to the request for information that I issued on December 4, 2024.


On March 27, 2025, Woodstock Aqueduct filed a motion to extend the stay of this proceeding until May 15, 2025. Woodstock Aqueduct states that it filed a petition with the Commission seeking approval of the sale of all its utility assets to the Town of Woodstock.¹ Woodstock Aqueduct also states that it further waives the statutory deadline for a Commission decision in this case pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 227(a) from April 30, 2025, to May 15, 2025. Woodstock Aqueduct states that it is authorized to represent that the Department and the Town and Village of Woodstock have no objection to this request.

The motion to stay this proceeding until May 15, 2025, is granted. Woodstock Aqueduct is directed to file a status update in this proceeding before May 15, 2025.
