ORDER RE SCHEDULE

This case involves a petition by Schurz Broadband Group, Inc. (“Schurz”) seeking approval of a controlling interest in Champlain Broadband, LLC, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 515.

On March 26, 2025, the Commission notified Schurz and the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”), the parties in this case, that a scheduling conference would be held on April 10, 2025. On April 7, 2025, Schurz filed a proposed schedule to which the Department agreed. On April 8, the parties clarified that given their agreement to the proposed schedule, they did not believe a scheduling conference would be necessary. Accordingly, I cancelled the scheduling conference set for April 10, 2025. I also hereby adopt the following schedule:

May 9, 2025	Parties engage in informal discovery
May 9, 2025	Deadline for comments from the parties or the public
To be determined	Scheduling conference, if necessary, for further proceedings


Parties are reminded that documents submitted in pdf format should be in an “unlocked” format, i.e., searchable and extractable, rather than in an image format.
