Dear Notice Parties:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you notice that ER Dunsmore, LLC (“DRS”) has submitted a Section 248 Petition to the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or “Commission”) for approval of a 4.95 MW solar electric generation facility to be located off of Dunsmore Road in St. Albans, Vermont (the “Project”). The Project will occupy approximately 30 acres of an approximately 114 acre parcel (+/-) off Dunsmore Road. Advance notice of DRS’s intent to file this Petition was previously sent out on December 19, 2024 and was assigned Case No. 24-3713-AN by the Commission.

The Commission deemed the Section 248 Petition administratively complete on May __, 2025 and has opened a new case to review the Project, which has been assigned Case No. 25-____-PET.
