Investigation of the standard-offer contract between Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC and the Standard Offer Facilitator	
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**GREEN MOUNTAIN POWER’S COMMENTS REGARDING
PROPOSAL FOR DECISION**

On June 9, 2025, the Hearing Officer issued a Proposal for Decision in the above-captioned matter recommending that the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) conclude that Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC’s (“VRG”) proposed 2.2 MW electric generation facility (the proposed “Facility”) is not eligible for a standard-offer contract under the farm methane category because the Facility, as proposed, “does not yield methane as the majority output of its engineering process and most of the proposed feedstock sources do not constitute feedstock from an agricultural operation.”¹ Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) does not have any comments or objections to the Proposal for Decision. GMP has not had an opportunity to review the supplemental testimony and new factual allegations in VRG’s June 20, 2025 filing in the above-captioned matter.
