REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On June 25, 2026, the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued a procedural order concerning the City of Burlington Electric Department’s (“BED”) June 20, 2025 letter titled “Planned Use of Surplus Thermal Energy and Process Fuels (“TEPF”) funds.” The order requires that comments on BED’s letter and requests for additional process be filed with the Commission no later than July 15, 2025. The Department of Public Service (“Department”) respectfully requests an extension of two weeks – until July 29, 2015 – to file comments, as several members of the Department staff who need to be involved in preparing and reviewing the Department’s response are currently out of the office or will be out of the office immediately prior to the original deadline.
