**NOTICE OF ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF
COMMISSIONING DEADLINE**

NOW COMES Randolph Davis Solar LLC (the “CPG Holder”), pursuant to Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) Rule 5.110(C), and hereby notifies the Commission and the parties that it is invoking its right to a one-year extension to commission the Randolph Davis Solar Facility (the “Facility”).

Rule 5.110(C) provides in relevant part:

A CPG holder may obtain an automatic one-year extension of time by providing written notice to the Commission and the electric company. Such notice must be (1) filed in the case in which the CPG was issued or deemed issued, unless the case is closed, in which case the filer should contact the Clerk, and (2) filed before the one-year anniversary of CPG issuance; otherwise the CPG will be deemed revoked.

The Commission issued a certificate of public good (“CPG”) for the Facility on August 12, 2024. Condition No. 5 of the CPG requires that the Facility be commissioned within one year from the date of issuance of the CPG, or by August 12, 2025. By this notice, the CPG Holder is invoking the automatic one-year extension permitted by the Rule, which will extend the commissioning date to August 12, 2026.
