CERTIFICATION OF ADVANCE NOTICE

1. Introduction. The purpose of this Certification of Advance Notice is to certify to the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) and the parties entitled to receive notice, the steps taken by MSK Attorneys (“MSK”) on behalf of Bell Atlantic Mobile Systems, LLC d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Verizon”) and The Towers, LLC, d/b/a Vertical Bridge (“VB”) to comply with the advance notice requirements set forth in 30 V.S.A. § 248a and the Commission’s *Order Implementing Standards and Procedures for Issuance of a Certificate of Public Good for Communications Facilities Pursuant to § 248a*, dated January 18, 2023 (“Procedures Order”).

2. Overview of the Project. On July 29, 2025, Verizon petitioned the Commission for a Certificate of Public Good (“CPG”) to construct a telecommunication facility on a parcel (“Parcel”) located at 2264 U.S. Route 2 in Marshfield, Vermont (“Project”). Verizon refers to the Project as “Marshfield”. The Tower owner has given Verizon and VB permission to proceed with this Application. The coordinates for the Project are: Latitude 44°-20'-51.01"± North and Longitude 72°-21'-55.74"± West

3. Advance Notice Requirements. Pursuant to the Procedures Order, Verizon was required to provide notice through ePUC or by written notice of its intent to submit a Section 248a petition—identifying the location of the Facility and providing a description of the proposed project in reasonable detail, at least 60 days in advance of filing the petition (“Advance Notice”), to the following entities:

- a. The legislative body and municipal and regional planning commissions in the communities where the facility is located;
- b. the Secretary of the Agency of Natural Resources;
- c. the Vermont Agency of Transportation;
- d. the Vermont Division for Historic Preservation;

- e. the Commissioner of the Department of Public Service and its Director for Public Advocacy;
- f. landowners of record of property adjoining the Site; and
- g. the Public Utility Commission.


The Advance Notice was first sent on September 23, 2024, the second Advance Notice was sent on May 8, 2025. We are filing a copy of the second Advance Notice separately.

4. Certification of the Adjoining Property Owners. The mailing addresses of the adjoining property owners were verified using the Towns of Marshfield Grand List and land records on April 29, 2025 and verified again current through July 16, 2025.

Based on the foregoing, the undersigned hereby certifies that it has complied with the advance notice requirements of 30 V.S.A. § 248a and the Procedures Order.
