PROCEDURAL ORDER APPROVING MOTION TO CHANGE SCHEDULE

This proceeding concerns a petition filed by VT Real Estate Holdings 2 LLC (“Petitioner”) for a certificate of public good for the installation and operation of a 20 MW solar electric generation facility in Fair Haven, Vermont.

On July 22, 2025, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an information request in the above-captioned case.

On July 28, 2025, the Commission issued an order granting a joint motion by the Petitioner and other parties to the case to alter the schedule for the remainder of the proceeding (“First Order”).

On July 29, 2025, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion requesting an additional change to the schedule for this proceeding beyond the changes granted in the First Order, namely that the Commission extend the deadline for comments from non-petitioners, as well as stipulations and associated testimony and exhibits (if any) from August 1, 2025, to August 8, 2025. The Department states that all parties indicated their consent to the extension of the deadline and that the extension would enable the Department to submit comments that are responsive to the Petitioner’s responses.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission grants the requested extension of the deadline for comments from non-petitioners, as well as stipulations and associated testimony and exhibits (if any) from August 1, 2025, to August 8, 2025. All other dates on the schedule for this proceeding remain the same as those contained in the First Order’s schedule.
