Dear Ms. Anderson,

On June 5, 2025, the Vermont Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") released an Order in Case No. 24-2317 - Investigation of the Energy Savings Account and Customer Credit Program addressing the application process for Energy Savings Account ("ESA") and Customer Credit Program ("CCP"). The Order set the deadline for existing ESA & ESA pilot program participants to file applications by July 18, 2025, and for the EEU and Department of Public Service ("the Department") to file recommendations on participation by August 7, 2025. The Order also sets the deadline for new ESA applicants to file applications by July 18, 2025, and for the EEU and the Department to file recommendations with respect to eligibility and acceptance by August 20, 2025. This filing provides Efficiency Vermont and the Department of Public Service's response of recommendations for both existing and new ESA & CCP applicants.

- i. Efficiency Vermont has confirmed with each ESA & CCP applicant their utility account numbers.
- ii. With the current pool of applicants for both ESA & CCP, Efficiency Vermont does not anticipate reaching program caps. The total EEC funds will not exceed the total annual amount of customer EEC funds that can be placed into an ESA program or the CCP, which is \$2,000,000 and \$1,000,000, respectively. Efficiency Vermont and the Department of Public Service agree that all applicants to ESA & CCP should be accepted into their respective programs of choice.
