I seek to be an intervenor in this tower case on aesthetics and the town plan. I have lived in my home, across from the Old Schoolhouse Common for 22 years. I live here with my husband, three children, and two dogs. I live and work in my community, and I care deeply for what happens in Marshfield. When I stand on my front porch, I will look directly at the proposed cell tower.

Aesthetics is my first reason for asking the location of the cell tower to be reconsidered.

My second concern with the proposed cell tower is that it is NOT IN COMPLIANCE with the Marshfield Town Plan and Telecommunications Bylaws. It is directly in the protected viewshed as outlined in these regulatory documents.

That town plan was created to protect our community, and I think we should abide by the plans and bylaws that are in place. No one else can protect my family and community's rights, so I have no choice but to intervene and request a hearing in support of and advocacy for our community and my family. Lastly, I would like to clarify that my family is not opposed to cell tower technology, but I think the location of this tower is wrong. It appears that the cell service will have limited reach, and I would like to preserve the character and beauty of our village.
