On May 5, 2025, ER Dunsmore, LLC (“Petitioner”) requested a certificate of public good (“CPG”), pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 8010 and 248 and Commission Rule 5.100, for the construction and operation of a 4.95 kW solar net-metering system in Saint Albans Town, Vermont (the proposed “Facility”).

On October 10, 2025, the Petitioner filed its Proposed Findings of Fact and Order (“Proposed Order”) and its proposed CPG.

In the Petitioner’s Proposed Order, the Petitioner noted in paragraph 6 that “the Project will require several miles of existing distribution line upgrades between the Project site and the **Village of Enosburg Falls.**” This proposed finding is at odds with the Petitioner’s description of the Facility and its planned interconnection to the Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) electric grid elsewhere in the evidentiary record.¹

I request that the Petitioner clarify the proposed finding quoted above, including any necessary changes to the prefiled testimony submitted in this case, and confirm the Facility’s interconnection plans. The Petitioner’s response to this request is due by Friday, October 24, 2025.
