Mr. Owens' testimony explains a revision to his report entitled "Aesthetic & Orderly Development Analysis Report" prepared by T.J. Boyle Associates, LLC, corrects a mistaken reference to the Project as having a lower capacity rating in his earlier testimony, and reaffirms his opinion on applicable Section 248 criteria as expressed in his earlier testimony.

1 **Introduction**

2 Q1. Please state your name, current employer, business address, and position.

3 A1. My name is Jeremy B. Owens. I am a licensed landscape architect with T.J. Boyle
4 Associates, Landscape Architects and Planning Consultants, with a business address of
5 301 College Street, Burlington, Vermont.

6 Q2. Have you testified previously in this matter?

7 A2. Yes. I submitted prefiled testimony with the Petition filing in this matter which testimony
8 is dated September 25, 2025.

10 Q3. What is the purpose of your first supplemental testimony?

11 A3. My supplemental testimony explains how I have revised and updated Exhibit WGKL-JO-
12 2, it corrects a factual error in my prior testimony which mistakenly referred to the Project's
13 capacity as 2.375 MW rather than the actual proposed capacity of 2.9 MW, and it affirms
14 that my previously-stated opinions that the Project complies with Section 248 criteria that
15 I evaluated within my expertise.

17 Q4. What revisions have you made to your report "Aesthetic & Orderly Development Analysis
18 Report" prepared by T.J. Boyle Associates, LLC filed originally as Exhibit WGKL-JO-2?

19 A4. My revised report corrects an error in the Project description (page 4) where the report
20 indicated that the Project capacity is proposed to be "2.375 MW" as was the case in the
21 Project's pre-filing advanced notice. In fact, my analysis reflected in the report pertains to
22 the Project as proposed in the Petition to have a capacity of 2.9 MW AC and a project

1 design consistent with the site plan filed with the Petition as Exhibit WGKL-JC-2. In
2 addition, I have updated a link to the Regional Energy Plan (Page 13) and updated the
3 report's cover page to indicate the revision date. I have submitted the Revised Exhibit
4 WGKL-JO-2 with all revisions indicated with redline.

5
6 Q5. Do the revisions to the exhibit and testimony referenced previously affect your opinions
7 on the Project's compliance with Section 248(b)(1) regarding orderly development of the
8 region or 28(b)(5) regarding aesthetics and scenic beauty?

9 A5. No. As stated above, despite the erroneous capacity references, the analysis in my expert
10 report and prior testimony were in fact based on an analysis of the Project as proposed in
11 the Petition to have a capacity of 2.9 MW and a project design consistent with the site plan
12 filed with the Petition as Exhibit WGKL-JC-2.

14 Q6. Does this conclude your testimony at this time?

15 A6. Yes, it does.
