ORDER ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE

This case a petition filed by Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC (“VRG”) requesting a certificate of public good (“CPG”), under 30 V.S.A. § 248(j), to construct and operate a 2.2 MW generation facility in Lyndon, Vermont (the proposed “Facility”). In a November 7, 2024, order, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) determined that the public interest will be best served by using the full procedures of 30 V.S.A. § 248 to review the petition for a CPG.

On October 29, 2025, I held a scheduling conference in this matter with representatives of VRG, the Vermont Department of Public Service, the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (“ANR”), and Conservation Law Foundation, and intervenors John Ling and Steve Dolgin.

At the scheduling conference, the parties discussed a schedule proposed by ANR and VRG. Based on the discussion, I adopt the following schedule.

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| November 3, 2025 | Deadline for VRG to file supplemental testimony |
| November 10, 2025 | Deadline for motions to intervene and deadline for requesting public hearing and/or site visit |
| November 17, 2025 | Deadline for responses to motions to intervene |
| December 3, 2025 | Deadline for discovery on VRG |
| December 23, 2025 | Deadline for VRG responses to discovery |
| January 30, 2026 | Deadline for testimony by non-petitioner parties |
| February 13, 2026 | Deadline for discovery on non-petitioners |
| March 13, 2026 | Deadline for non-petitioners to respond to discovery |
| March 20, 2026 | Deadline for VRG to file rebuttal testimony |
| April 8, 2026 | Deadline for discovery on non-petitioners |

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| April 22, 2026 | Deadline for non-petitioners to respond to discovery |
| May 15, 2026 | Deadline for surrebuttal testimony by non-petitioners |
| May 28, 2026 | Evidentiary hearing, with briefing schedule determined at hearing |

Members of the public interested in this proceeding may participate by submitting public comments or by intervening as a formal party to the case. Members of the public may also simply monitor the Commission's actions in a specific case. Guidance on how to monitor, comment on, or actively participate in Commission proceedings is available in the document "Public Participation and Intervention in Proceedings before the Public Utility Commission," which is available on the Commission's website at: <https://puc.vermont.gov/document/public-participation-and-intervention-proceedings-public-utility-commission>.

Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 20 and 21, VRG will be responsible for court reporter costs incurred by the Commission during the course of this proceeding and billed back to VRG. Unless VRG informs the Commission otherwise, the Commission will mail the invoice for these costs to the attorney of record or the official representative for VRG.
