**ORDER RE SCHEDULE**

This case involves a petition filed by Northland Solar, LLC (the “Petitioner”) on October 1, 2025, for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) under 30 V.S.A. § 248a, with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) authorizing the installation of telecommunications equipment in Lowell, Vermont.

On October 31, 2025, I held a scheduling conference in this matter. Appearances were entered by Victoria Westgate, Esq. and Zachary Berger, Esq., on behalf of the Petitioner, Charles Peel, Esq., on behalf of the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources; and Michael Swain, Esq., on behalf of the Vermont Department of Public Service<sup>1</sup>.

On October 28, 2025, the parties submitted a jointly proposed schedule for this proceeding. Based upon that submission, I adopt the proposed schedule below:

Deadline for motions to intervene and requests for site visit and public hearing	November 7, 2025
Deadline for response to motions to intervene and requests for site visit and public hearing	November 14, 2025
Deadline for discovery on Petitioner	November 21, 2025
Deadline for Petitioner response to discovery <sup>2</sup>	December 12, 2025
Deadline for second round of discovery on Petitioner	January 2, 2026


<sup>1</sup> Mathew Bakerpoole, Esq, appeared on behalf of Mr. Swain at the scheduling conference.

If any such discovery is served and the corresponding motion is granted, the Petitioner will then respond to that discovery. If the corresponding motion is denied, then the Petitioner would not respond to that discovery.

If matter is uncontested:	
Petitioner files proposed order and CPG	January 30, 2026
If matter is contested:	
Parties files proposed litigation schedule(s)	January 30, 2026
