RESPONSE TO OBJECTION TO INTERVENE

I, Madonna Sullivan, hereby respond to Northland Solar's Objection to become an intervener.

As such, I will have a direct and individualized view of the project that is not shared by any other person or party to this proceeding. My property interests are uniquely and specifically affected, and no other existing party is positioned to adequately represent or protect those interests. Every window on the west, north, and east sides of my residence looks directly onto this field (picture below). As a result, I will have a clear and unavoidable view of the proposed installation, placing me in a uniquely impacted position not shared by any other person or party to this proceeding.

Accordingly, intervention is necessary to ensure the protection of my property rights and aesthetic interests, and there is no alternative means by which those interests can be safeguarded within this proceeding. My participation will not unduly delay the proceeding or prejudice the interests of any existing party.
