**PETITIONER’S RESPONSE TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE’S MOTION  
TO CHANGE SCHEDULE**

Petitioner Northland Solar LLC (“NS”) hereby responds to the Department of Public Service’s (the “Department”) Motion to Change Schedule filed today and requesting to change the date of the upcoming site visit scheduled for December 11, 2025 (the “Site Visit”). NS has spent significant time coordinating the site visit for the 11<sup>th</sup>, including clearing attorney schedules and making non-cancellable travel arrangements starting tomorrow so as to be able to spend the day on Wednesday the 10<sup>th</sup> setting up markers requested by the Town of Lowell. As a result, given the late notice of the Department’s conflict<sup>1</sup>, moving the site visit at this point would be prejudicial to NS.

The Department also does not propose an alternative date, thereby seeking to delay the site visit for an unspecified amount of time. If helpful to the Department, NS is amenable to starting the Site Visit at 1pm as opposed to noon. If that does not work for the Department, NS will cooperate with the Department in the event that it hires a consultant who would like to access the Project site in the future, but respectfully objects to rescheduling the Site Visit to another date at this juncture. NS therefore respectfully requests that the Commission deny the Department’s motion and continue to hold the Site Visit as scheduled.
