ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CHANGE SCHEDULE

This case involves a petition filed by Northland Solar, LLC (the “Petitioner”) on October 1, 2025, for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) under 30 V.S.A. § 248, with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) authorizing the installation of a solar generation facility (“Project”) in Lowell, Vermont.

On December 8, 2025, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion to postpone the site visit scheduled for December 11, 2025, to an unspecified later date due to a scheduling conflict.

On November 9, 2025, the Petitioner filed in opposition to the motion.

On November 9, 2025, the Town of Lowell (“Town”) filed in support of the motion.

The Petitioner contends that, given the late notice of the Department’s scheduling conflict, postponing the site visit after the Petitioner has made significant arrangements would be prejudicial to the Petitioner.


The Town, while expressing concerns with the motion, argues that the site visit should be postponed due to inclement weather forecasted for the 11th.¹

I agree with the Town that, given the current weather forecast, it would be prudent to postpone the site visit. Therefore, I grant the Department’s motion, and the site visit is rescheduled for December 12, 2025, at 12:00 P.M.

¹ The Town also expresses concerns with the schedule for the case. If the Town seeks to modify the existing case schedule, the Town needs to file a motion to change the schedule and allow an opportunity for the other parties to respond.

SO ORDERED.


