MOTION TO CLARIFY

On November 7, 2025, the Commission issued an order on Petitioner’s Motion to Set Aside the Hearing Officer’s Proposal for Decision. The Commission granted the motion and directed the Hearing Officer to “solicit schedule(s) from the parties to litigate the issue presented by the Town’s comments.”

The Town requests clarification from the Commission as to whether the scope of remand in this petition involves directing a full evidentiary process for issuing a potential CPG to Petitioner in the ordinary course, or a more limited process involving litigating the issue raised in the Town’s comments, i.e., the substance of its Recommendation, which created a rebuttable presumption in favor of denying the CPG, in a summary-judgment posture pursuant to Commission Rule 2.219.
