**ORDER AMENDING SCHEDULE**

This case involves a petition filed by Northland Solar, LLC (the “Petitioner”) on October 1, 2025, for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) under 30 V.S.A. § 248a, with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) authorizing the installation of telecommunications equipment in Lowell, Vermont.

On December 31, 2025, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion to amend the schedule for this proceeding to allow time for the Department’s aesthetic expert review. The Department states that Town of Lowell, the Agency of Natural Resources, and the Petitioner have consented to the schedule.

On January 8, 2026, Douglas Manning, Madonna Sullivan, the Lowell Graded School, the Lowell Cemetery Association, and Michael Tetrault (together the “Intervenors”) filed a response to the motion stating they had no objection.<sup>1</sup>

I find the Department’s proposed schedule to be reasonable. Therefore, I adopt the schedule below:


