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MOTION TO ALTER SCHEDULE

Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC (“VRG”) moves to alter the schedule by enlarging the dates in the schedule included in the Commission’s Scheduling Order dated October 30, 2025 in the above-referenced matter by extending all of the remaining deadlines by two months (approximately sixty (60) days though some dates adjusted to avoid falling on a weekend or holiday).

Further, this proposed schedule corrects an apparent error in the description of two of the “Events” to conform to VRG’s original scheduling order proposal as agreed to by the Vermont Public Service Department, Agency of Agriculture Food and Markets, and Agency of Natural Resources. The proposed changes to the schedule are as follows:

The enlargement of time is requested to allow VRG to respond to requests from the Agency of Natural Resources, Agency of Agriculture Farm and Markets, and Public Service Department for additional information relating to the proposed project and to engage in good faith discussions regarding the development of memoranda of understandings if the agencies desire. proposed enlargement of time and all three support this motion.
