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JOINT PROPOSED SCHEDULE OF INDUSTRIAL TOWER AND WIRELESS, LLC, THE TOWN OF TINMOUTH, AND THE VERMONT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE

On January 7, 2026, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order which requested that the parties submit a joint, or separate, proposed schedules, in accordance to Commission Rule 2.225, by January 23, 2026. Industrial Tower and Wireless, LLC (“ITW” or the “Petitioner”) and the Town of Tinmouth, Vermont (“Tinmouth”), and the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) and have agreed the following schedule.

Counsel for ITW and the Department have contacted Intervenor Jaquay, Guettel, and Carabeau about this schedule but they have not responded to ITW (the Department had some scheduling communications with Ms. Jaquay and Mr. Guettel)¹ or given a final opinion regarding this proposed schedule.

¹ The Department has received an email from Mr. Guettel and understands that he does not agree to any process regarding Intervenor claims until the questions regarding Tinmouth’s recommendation are resolved (Aside from, perhaps, supporting the initial Non-Petitioner discovery upon ITW. Mr. Guettel expressed this opinion via email with the understanding that ITW would answer on a different date than currently proposed.). The Department also discussed the schedule with Ms. Jaquay and Ms. Carabeau and the Department understands they support Mr. Guettel’s position that Tinmouth’s recommendation should be addressed before the Intervenor’s issue.
