INTERVENORS' RESPONSE TO MOTION TO ALTER SCHEDULE

NOW come Intervenors Steve Dolgin, Ernest and Madeline Hastings, John Ling, and Mark Simakaski and respond to Vermont Renewable Gas (VRG) Motion to Alter Schedule filed in this case on January 23, 2026.

Intervenors support the Motion to Alter Schedule and the proposed changes to the schedule.

VRG did not contact any of the Intervenors other than the state agencies prior to submission of its Motion to Alter Schedule and proposed changes to the schedule.

As *pro se* parties, Intervenors perhaps incorrectly anticipated the PUC Hearing Officer would issue a decision on VRG's Motion to Alter Schedule prior to today's deadline for non-petitioning parties to submit prefiled testimony. Given that VRG and the state agencies agreed to the Motion to Alter Schedule and the proposed changes to the schedule, Intervenors assumed that the change in schedule would be granted and therefore will not be submitting prefiled testimony today.

In addition, Intervenors requested a site visit and public hearing, and expected those events would occur prior to the submission of non-petitioner prefiled testimony. Intervenors

renew the request for public hearing and site visit, and request those events be added to the changed schedule so they occur prior to the new deadline for non-petitioner prefiled testimony.
