**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE’S MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE**

The Department of Public Service (“Department”) respectfully requests that the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) grant the Department’s proposed change in schedule shown below. The purpose of this request is to allow the Department’s expert consultants, Environmental Design and Research (“EDR”) to complete testimony and visual simulations. Winter weather has delayed EDR’s site work, which is necessary to complete before simulations and testimony can be created. The schedule changes proposed below would provide the Department, and all other non-petitioners, with two additional weeks to file testimony. The proposed schedule would push back all other remaining deadlines by two weeks.

The Department has received consent for the proposed change in schedule from Northland Solar and the representative for the intervenors and the Town of Lowell. The Agency of Natural Resources has stated it has no objection to the proposed change in schedule
