ORDER AMENDING SCHEDULE

This case involves a petition filed by Northland Solar, LLC (the “Petitioner”) on October 1, 2025, for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) under 30 V.S.A. § 248a, with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) authorizing the installation of telecommunications equipment in Lowell, Vermont.

On December 31, 2025, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion to amend the schedule for this proceeding to allow additional time for the Department’s aesthetic expert review. The Department states that Town of Lowell, the Agency of Natural Resources, a representative for the intervenors, and the Petitioner have consented to the schedule.

On March 16, 2026, the Town of Lowell, Douglas Manning, Madonna Sullivan, the Lowell Graded School, the Lowell Cemetery Association, and Michael Tetrault (together the “Intervenors”) filed a response to the motion stating they withdraw their consent to the Department’s motion.¹

I find the Department’s proposed schedule to be reasonable. Therefore, I adopt the schedule below:


Non-Petitioner direct testimony due	March 27, 2026
Discovery on non-Petitioners due	April 10, 2026
Non-Petitioners response to discovery due	April 24, 2026

¹ The Intervenors also moved that the Department’s aesthetic testimony be excluded because it would be late-filed according to the existing schedule. However, because I am granting the Department’s motion to extend the schedule that request is moot and the motion is denied.

Rebuttal testimony	May 8, 2026
Parties submit proposed date(s) for an evidentiary hearing	May 15, 2026


