Re: Case No. 26-____-PET: Petition of Savage Solar Energy LLC for a Certificate of Public Good, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248, authorizing the installation and operation of a 2.75 MW solar electric generation facility off Route 103 in Chester, Vermont to be known as the "Savage Solar Energy Project"

Dear Landowner:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you notice that Savage Solar Energy LLC ("SSE") has submitted a petition to the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") for approval of a 2.75 MW solar photovoltaic electric generation facility off Route 103 in Chester, Vermont (the "Project"). The Project will occupy approximately 14.18 acres of an approximately 25.72 acre parcel of land off Route 103. Advance notice of SSE's intent to file this Petition was previously sent out on July 11, 2026, and assigned Case No. 25-1365-AN.

The Commission deemed the petition administratively complete on March __, 2026 and has opened a new case to review the Project, which has been assigned Case No. 26-____-PET.
