**SECOND MOTION TO ALTER SCHEDULE**

Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC (“VRG”) moves to alter the schedule in the above-referenced matter by further enlarging the dates in the schedule included in the Commission’s Scheduling Order dated October 30, 2025 beyond the dates proposed in VRG’s Motion to Alter Schedule dated January 23, 2026.

In the table below, VRG proposes extending all deadlines by five additional weeks. Part of the reason for the length of time requested is that VRG proposes add three weeks to allow VRG to file supplemental testimony reflecting information and additional proposed conditions being developed based on continued discussions with the Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets (AAFM), the Agency of Natural Resources (ANR), and the Department of Public Service (PSD). VRG has been working diligently to address these agencies’ questions and concerns and has made significant progress but needs additional time to complete this work.

The other reason for the length of time requested is to provide the non-petitioners with a two-week period following the submission of VRG’s supplemental testimony before filing their testimony so that the non-petitioners can respond to that testimony.


