ORDER ESTABLISHING SECOND REVISED SCHEDULE

This case a petition filed by Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC (“VRG”) requesting a certificate of public good (“CPG”), under 30 V.S.A. § 248, to construct and operate a 2.2 MW generation facility in Lyndon, Vermont (the proposed “Facility”).

In an April 8, 2026, order, a revised schedule was set in this proceeding.

There was some confusion on the part of the hearing officer with respect to the schedule proposed by VRG. I am making a second revision to reflect the proposed schedule attached to VRG’s March 30, 2026, filing.¹ The revised schedule adds a deadline for VRG’s supplemental testimony and changes the date for the public hearing and some of the deadlines for discovery and testimony.

Accordingly, I adopt the following schedule.

April 21, 2026	Deadline for supplemental testimony by VRG
April 23, 2026	Site visit at 11 A.M. (A separate notice is issued for site visit logistics.)
April 30, 2026	Virtual public hearing at 7 P.M., with Department information session at 6:30 P.M.
May 5, 2026	Deadline for testimony by non-petitioner parties
May 19, 2026	Deadline for discovery on non-petitioners
June 16, 2026	Deadline for non-petitioners to respond to discovery
June 23, 2026	Deadline for VRG to file rebuttal testimony
July 7, 2026	Deadline for discovery on VRG concerning VRG rebuttal testimony

¹ I note that any future proposals to change the schedule should be filed as separate motions in the case.

July 28, 2026	Deadline for VRG to respond to discovery
August 18, 2026	Deadline for surrebuttal testimony by non-petitioners
August 24, 2026	Evidentiary hearing, with briefing schedule determined at hearing

Finally, as a reminder to parties and participants, the purpose of the public hearing is to provide an opportunity to hear input from the public on the proposed facility.² The comments received at the virtual hearing will be recorded and become part of the public record in this case but not the evidentiary record. Although public comments do not become part of the formal evidence in this case, they can be helpful in raising new issues or perspectives that the Commission should consider.
