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DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE’S MOTION TO CHANGE SCHEDULE

The Department of Public Service (“Department”) respectfully requests that the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) grant the Department’s proposed change in schedule below. The purpose of this request is to extend the schedule to allow the Department to meet with the petitioner to discuss the potential for aesthetics mitigation. The schedule changes proposed below would allow the Department, and all other non-petitioners, twelve additional days to respond to discovery requests and would push back all other subsequent deadlines by twelve days. The need for the Department and Petitioner to discuss mitigation represents good cause to grant the requested extension and will help progress this case toward a resolution.

The Department has received consent from Northland Solar and has shared this motion with the Intervenor, Agency of Natural Resources, and Agency of Agriculture, Food, and Markets shortly before filing.
