VHB performed a wetlands and waters survey on May 10, 2024, and October 4, 2024. Other natural resources were not field accessed.

The site has not been reviewed by the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation, wetland Program or the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. All wetland boundaries, Classifications and buffers should be considered preliminary until field review with State and Federal Regulators as applicable have been complete.

Proposed Green Mountain Power ("GMP") pole and utility locations are approximated by VHB using specifications provided by GMP.

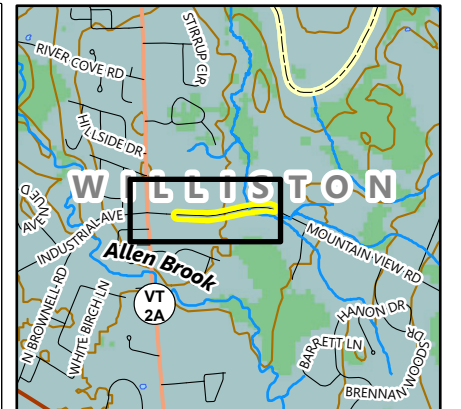
All poles west of the Study Area to US Route-2 have been upgraded by GMP as part of the separate Route-2 Corridor Upgrade Project.

From a site visit with GMP on February 2, 2026, GMP confirmed the line upgrade will not require any tree cutting or limbing. VHB understands ongoing vegetation management within the existing corridor will be conducted as line maintenance in accordance with GMP vegetation management procedures.

Streams will be crossed via existing roadways, with no permanent or temporary crossing improvements needed.

Construction equipment access will be achieved from the existing roadway and/or low-ground pressure equipment, no soil disturbance from access is anticipated.

New, replacement, and removed poles within Class II wetland and buffer areas to be completed by GMP in accordance with BMPs defined under Vermont Wetland Rule Sections 6.8 and 6.12 as applicable.
