**PETITIONER’S RESPONSE TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE’S MOTION  
TO AMEND SCHEDULE**

Petitioner Northland Solar LLC (“Petitioner”) hereby responds to the Department of Public Service’s (“DPS” or “Department”) Motion to Change Schedule, filed on April 21, 2026. Petitioner supports the DPS extension request as Petitioner is in the process of working to add additional aesthetic mitigation measures to the Project in response to testimony filed by other parties, and plans to include these revisions in the rebuttal testimony and exhibits that will be due on May 20, 2026 under the Department’s proposed amended schedule. With this in mind, Petitioner would further suggest that the schedule be amended to incorporate a surrebuttal deadline prior to an evidentiary hearing in order to provide other parties an opportunity to respond to the additional mitigation measures that Petitioner proposes. Petitioner suggests that a surrebuttal deadline three weeks after the rebuttal deadline would be appropriate but recognizes that other parties may wish to comment on this deadline as well.
