PETITIONER’S MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULE

On May 1, 2026, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order in this proceeding amending the schedule. Under this schedule, the only remaining procedural deadline is the submission of proposed date(s) for an evidentiary hearing on May 27, 2026. Consistent with the suggestion Petitioner Northland Solar LLC (“NS”) included in its comment letter to the Commission on May 1, 2026, NS is hereby proposing to further amend the schedule as follows to add in a surrebuttal deadline as an opportunity for other parties to respond to the reduced Project footprint submitted by Petitioner as a response to the testimony submitted by other parties.¹ Petitioner has also proposed certain dates for the evidentiary hearing.

Proposed Schedule for Remainder of Proceeding:

Event	Deadline
Non-Petitioners file surrebuttal testimony	June 10, 2026
Parties file witness order and anticipated timing of witness examinations, and comprehensive exhibit list and stipulations as to admission of testimony and exhibits	June 19, 2026
Evidentiary hearings	June 29-July 2, 2026

¹ In communications with Petitioner about the proposed schedule changes, the Town of Lowell has suggested that the revisions to the Project design submitted in rebuttal are “substantial changes” requiring notice under Commission Rule 5.412. While Petitioner strongly disagrees that responsive changes to the Town’s concerns that reduce the Project size and impacts is a substantial change under the Rule, Petitioner is nonetheless providing notice of this change to adjoining landowners, parties, and entities entitled to notice under Section 248 concurrent with this motion.

Deadline to file briefs	14 days after hearing
Deadline to file reply briefs	10 days after initial briefs are filed

Petitioner has shared the above proposed schedule with the other parties. The Department of Public Service, the Agency of Agriculture, Food, & Markets, and the Agency of Natural Resources have each consented to this schedule. The Town of Lowell has indicated that it does not consent.
