STATUS UPDATE REQUEST

On May 7, 2026, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) received Novus Buck Solar LLC’s (“Petitioner”) petition to construct a 4.999 MW solar electric generation facility in Newport Town, Vermont.

At the same time as the Petitioner filed the petition, it also filed a motion requesting that the Commission waive the completeness requirements related to Commission Rule 5.403(A)(1) and Commission Rule 5.403(A)(14).

On May 13, 2026, Commission staff issued a memorandum finding the petition incomplete and setting a deadline of May 22, 2026, for responses to the Petitioner’s motion.

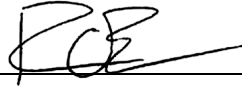
On May 22, 2026, the Department of Public Service filed a response.

The Petitioner stated that Vermont Electric Cooperative (“VEC”) – the interconnecting utility – had informed the Petitioner that VEC anticipated issuing a System Impact Study (“SIS”) around May 15, 2026.

As this date has passed, the Petitioner is requested to provide a status update by June 2, 2026, regarding when it now expects the SIS to be issued.
