NOTICE OF STATUS CONFERENCE

On October 22, 2025, the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("Commission") opened an investigation into the City of Burlington Electric Department's ("BED") operations and management practices. In this order, we are noticing a status conference and identifying certain topics to be discussed at the conference.

On May 29, 2026, in response to an information request from the Commission, the Vermont Department of Public Service filed a copy of the contract it had executed with an independent consultant to conduct a business process audit as part of this investigation.

As a next step, we are scheduling a status conference to discuss the status of the BED business process audit and set a schedule for the remainder of the investigation. The parties should be ready to discuss the following matters at the conference:

- work completed to date by the consultant under the contract;
- timeline of the contract and/or anticipated end date of the audit;
- suggested process for presentation and review of the audit final report; and
- a proposed schedule to accommodate the remaining process in this investigation.

We encourage the parties to confer in advance of the status conference in an effort to arrive at an agreed-upon process and schedule for the remainder of this investigation.

The status conference will be held at 1:00 P.M. on June 9, 2026, via Teams videoconference.

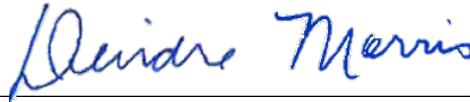

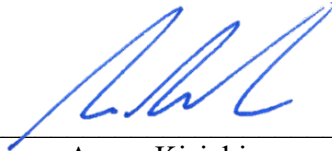

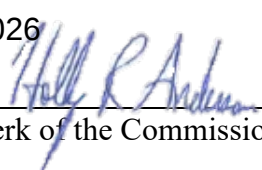
