ORDER GRATING A NON-SUBSTANTIAL CHANGE DETERMINATION

This case involves a petition filed by Industrial Tower and Wireless, LLC (“Petitioner”) on August 8, 2025, for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) under 30 V.S.A. § 248a, with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) authorizing the installation of telecommunications equipment in Tinmouth, Vermont.

On April 8, 2026, the Petitioner filed a motion requesting a non-substantial change determination.

On April 20, 2026, the Town of Tinmouth filed a response stating it does not oppose the motion.

On April 21, 2026, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a response in support of the motion.

No other comments were received by the Commission.

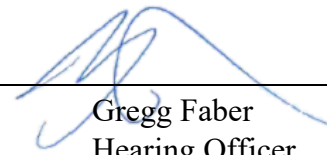
The Project included the installation of a tower with a height of 160’. The Petitioner is now proposing to reduce the height of the tower to 130’.

Based on the materials filed by the Petitioner, I conclude that the minor modifications will qualify as *de minimis* modifications and will not have a significant impact under any relevant criteria. Therefore, I conclude that the revision does not constitute a substantial change to the originally approved Project and, accordingly, does not require further proceedings.

Because the Project’s CPG requires that construction of the Project be done in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding, I hereby admit into the evidentiary record of this case the Petitioner’s request along with the supplemental prefiled testimony of Kevin Delaney and Louis Hodgetts and the revised exhibits LH-1, LH-6, and KD-1.

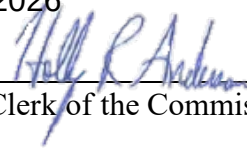
