**Re: Case Number 21-1054-NM
Response to Second Order Requiring Additional Information
Revised Aesthetic Certification and Comprehensive Filing**

An Order Requiring Additional Information dated 07/03/2026 and a Second Order Requiring Additional Information dated 07/02/2026 was issued regarding rb Technologies, LLC (“CPG Holder”) compliance with aesthetic mitigation work and certification requirements of certificate of public good (“CPG”) Case No. 21-1054-NM.

As stated in the 21-1054-NM Application Net-Metering Aesthetics Information, the applicant “intends to plant several crab apple trees along Carleton Boulevard to provide screening of the array from the road and neighboring structures. To the west of the array site is US Route 14 South.”

As outlined in Installer Comments on Aesthetic Mitigation Plan and accompanying Aesthetics Exhibits 1 & 2 dated 06/12/2025 (also included below), rb Technologies (“CPG Holder”) and SunCommon (the “Installer”) confirmed that the project is in compliance and all aesthetic mitigation work has been fully implemented in a manner consistent with the mitigation plan.

This commitment was fulfilled during the time of installation, August 16, 2021. The project received permission to operate from Green Mountain Power on November 3, 2021.
