ORDER ESTABLISHING RESPONSE DEADLINE

This case concerns a petition filed by Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC (“VRG”) requesting a certificate of public good (“CPG”), under 30 V.S.A. § 248, to construct and operate a 2.2 MW generation facility in Lyndon, Vermont (the proposed “Facility”).

On August 10, 2026, VRG filed objections, under Commission Rule 2.216(D), to exclude the entirety of the testimony and exhibits submitted by Steven Dolgin and Ernest and Madeline Hastings.

Under Commission Rule 2.216(D)(3), if an objection to the admissibility of prefiled testimony or exhibits is filed, all parties may file a response, but no replies in support of the objection are allowed without permission of the Commission.

The deadline for parties to file responses to VRG’s objections is August 24, 2026.

I note that the evidentiary hearing is scheduled for August 24, 2026. For purposes of the hearing, VRG’s objections will be noted and taken under advisement. My ruling on whether the prefiled testimony and exhibits will be admitted into the evidentiary record will be made after the hearing.

Before adjourning the evidentiary hearing, I will discuss with the parties the timeline for my ruling on VRG’s objections and the due dates for post-hearing briefs and reply briefs.
