ORDER SUSPENDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

This case concerns a petition filed by Vermont Renewable Gas, LLC (“VRG”) requesting a certificate of public good, under 30 V.S.A. § 248, to construct and operate a 2.2 MW generation facility in Lyndon, Vermont.

On August 10, 2026, VRG filed objections, under Commission Rule 2.216(D), to exclude the entirety of the testimony and exhibits submitted by Steven Dolgin and Madeline Hastings.

On August 24, 2026, Steven Dolgin and Ernest and Madeline Hastings (collectively “Intervenors”) and the Vermont Department Public Service separately filed responses to VRG’s motion.

An evidentiary hearing in this case was conducted on August 24, 2026, with VRG’s objections noted and taken under advisement. Before adjourning the evidentiary hearing, I discussed with the parties the timeline for my ruling on VRG’s objections and the due dates for post-hearing briefs and reply briefs. The deadline for briefs was September 11, 2026, and reply briefs on September 18, 2026.

I am suspending the briefing schedule to provide more time to prepare my order ruling on VRG’s objections. The deadline for briefs will be 14 days from the issue date of my order ruling on VRG’s objections and the deadline for reply briefs will be 21 days from the issue date.
