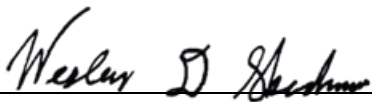
PROCEDURAL ORDER REQUESTING SCHEDULE PROPOSAL

On August 18, 2026, Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) filed a petition pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 248 for authorization to relocate and rebuild the Taftsville Substation and related facilities in the Towns of Woodstock, Hartford, and Hartland, Vermont.

The parties are directed to consult with one another and jointly propose a schedule — or, if the parties cannot agree on a schedule, separate proposed schedules — for the remainder of this proceeding. The schedule proposal is due by September 18, 2026. I will establish a schedule in this case following the submission of a proposed schedule(s) by the parties unless a scheduling conference is requested.
