ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Vermont Public Service Board ("Board") issued an Order in this docket on January 6, 1995, that requires all providers of operator services to make a variety of filings with the Board by March 6, 1995. Specifically, providers of operator services are required to revise their tariffed rates to comply with the rate caps mandated in the Order. On January 10, 1997, the Board sent letters to several telecommunications providers, including Capital Network System, Inc. ("CNI"), advising them that their rates for operator services do not comport with the Board's rate cap requirement established in this Order.

CNI has failed to file with the Board the required revisions to its tariffed rates for operator services. Consequently, CNI is hereby ordered to show cause, within thirty days of the date of this Order, why its Certificate of Public Good ("CPG") to offer telecommunications services in Vermont should not be revoked. If no response is received within this period of time, the CPG issued to CNI on June 14, 1992 (CPG No. 142) may, after opportunity for hearing, be revoked pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 231(a).
