ORDER RE: COMPLIANCE

The Board issued an Order in this docket on January 6, 1995, that requires all providers of operator services to make a variety of filings with the Board by March 6, 1995. The Order also requires the Department of Public Service ("DPS" or "the Department") to make a filing with the Board. To date, only a few of the parties and interested persons have made the requisite filings. Since there appears to be some confusion about the requirements of the Board's initial Order, we will authorize an extension of time until May 17, 1995, to make the filings. A list of the required filings is provided below.

Each party, and each interested person, should note that if it believes it is exempt from any filing requirement, it must file a letter with the Board so indicating and explaining the basis for its belief.

Failure to comply with these directives may result in sanctions under 30 V.S.A. § 30.

Required Filings

1. As discussed in paragraph 2(13) of the Board's Order, the DPS shall file a report regarding: (a) the status of the Department of Corrections' investigation into pay phone services in institutions of confinement; and (b) its recommendation as to whether the Board should open a separate proceeding devoted to that subject.

2. As discussed in paragraph 2(17) of the Board's Order, all providers of operator services must file tariff amendments with the Board so as to ensure that all of their tariffs are in compliance with the requirements of the Board's Order.
