**ORDER RE COMMENTS ON LYONS’ REQUEST FOR INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGED
VIOLATIONS OF CPG’S BLASTING PLAN REQUIREMENTS**

On September 14, 2017, Kristin Lyons requested that the Vermont Public Utility Commission¹ (the “Commission”) open an investigation, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 30, 208, and 209, of Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. for alleged violations of the approved blasting plan² during the construction of the pipeline. Any comments on this request shall be filed no later than the close of business on Friday, October 6, 2017. Should the Commission determine to open an investigation in response to Ms. Lyons’ request, a new docket will be created in ePUC with new parties.

SO ORDERED.

1. Pursuant to Section 9 of Act 53 of the 2017 legislative session, the Vermont Public Service Board’s name was changed to the Vermont Public Utility Commission, effective July 1, 2017.
