PROCEDURAL ORDER REQUESTING COMMENTS ON
WHETHER PROCEEDING SHOULD BE CLOSED

The Vermont Public Utility Commission¹ (“Commission”) initiated this proceeding to develop the second Demand Resources Plan (“DRP”) for the energy efficiency utility (“EEU”) program. A DRP includes short- and long-term energy efficiency budgets and energy savings goals, performance indicators for each EEU for the three-year performance period, and descriptions of services to be provided by each EEU. The long-term components of a DRP are revisited every three years through subsequent DRP processes.

The three-year performance period covered by this DRP was 2015-2017. This period is now past, and the next DRP has been reviewed in proceeding number EEU-2016-03. Accordingly, participants in this case are requested to comment on whether the instant proceeding should now be closed. Any such comments should be filed on or before June 15, 2018.

¹ Pursuant to Section 9 of Act 53 of the 2017 legislative session, the Vermont Public Service Board’s name was changed to the Vermont Public Utility Commission, effective July 1, 2017. For clarity, activities of the Vermont Public Service Board that occurred before the name change will be referred to in Commission documents as activities of the Commission unless that would be confusing in the specific context.
