MOTION TO CHANGE SCHEDULE

NOW come Libby Harris, *pro se*, and Apple Hill Homeowners Association represented by Lora Block, *pro se*, and move to change the date of the technical hearing.

Last week, Intervenor Harris became aware of an unreconcilable conflict with the planned date of the technical hearing in this case, Sept. 13, 2018. Upon inquiry to the parties to this case regarding moving the technical hearing to the following day, Sept. 14, petitioner’s attorney Michael Melone indicated he anticipated the hearing may take two days, and so he objected to moving the hearing to Sept. 14. Intervenor Block then provided notification that she is not available on Sept. 14. Therefore, it makes sense to change the technical hearing date, as it would not be possible to have it continue to the next day if the Sept. 13 hearing date is kept.

In response to requests for input on moving the hearing to the following week, DPS attorney Jake Clark and Town of Bennington attorney Merrill Bent are available any date the week of Sept. 17, as are Intervenor Harris, Block, McEver and Maru Leon of Mt. Anthony Country Club. ANR attorney Donald Einhorn is not available Sept. 17 and 18. Petitioner Melone indicate they will not agree to moving the hearing date to the


following week, and suggest the prior week in September or the last week in August.

Petitioner Melone did not state that they are unavailable the week of Sept. 17, but stated they will not agree to moving the hearing date later. No other parties responded.

Based on the above, Intervenors Harris and Block hereby move to change the date of the technical hearing to Sept. 19, 20 or 21 such that if the hearing does need to go into a second day, it could be continued to the following day. Harris and Block also move to adjust the subsequent dates in the schedule by the number of days that the change in technical hearing date entails.
